
ABOUT THE FOUNDER & INSTITUTE

CHILD, YOUTH, & FAMILY SERVICES

IMCES is dedicated to preserving and strengthening

families and while also promoting the healthy growth of children into adults. Our services and programs include:

Assessment

We provide ongoing assessment and

treatment to children, youth and families.



EPSDT is designed to improve the health and wellness of children from low-income families through the PEI approach.

Prevention Early Intervention (PEI)

Our PEI services are designed based on Evidence Based Practices (EBP). We provide Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (TF-CBT) and Managing and Adapting Practice (MAP) method of intervention. These services are delivered through schools and our clinics.

• Family Preservation

The Family Preservation program works with courts and child protective services, ensuring protection of the child by keeping the family unit intact.

WrapAround

The WrapAround program is designed to protect children and youth who are at risk of out-of-home placement. This program "wraps around" family and youth by providing comprehensive, effective, early intervention services.

Professional & Clinical Training / Internship Programs

tMCES is a clinical training institute and provides internships for the field of:

- Psychology/ Pre & Post Doctoral - Social Work

- Marriage and Family Therapy

Our clinical training program is designed to promote the specialty area of "community mental health". Our training is focused on an integrated model of service delivery. We provide our therapists with culturally proficient intervention skills in addition to the tools needed to promote wellness for individuals, families and the communities in which they live in through advocacy and outreach and engagement.
